Kyle Kuser's Presentation:

- Kyle Kuser, Aquatic Director- kyle.kuser@gmsd.org
- We will need **EVERYONE** to volunteer at all the home dual meets and the invitational. Includes, set up, clean up, timers, and concession stand.
- Swim Board Meetings on the **First Wednesday of the Month at 6pm** in the GMIS cafeteria.
- Thank you to the high school coaches we were able to get more practice time this year (some age groups bumped up from two practices to four practices this year) ...please see the website for schedule.
- Parents must be prompt for drop of and pick up...5 to 10 minutes before practice begins and 5 to 10 minutes prior to practice ending.
- It is recommended, that parents of 8 and unders, come up to the doors to get their child. It will be dark, and it will be hard to see the children having to cross the intersection. There will always be a coach in the vestibule to wait with the swimmers.
- Swimmers must arrive in suits and leave in suits. No locker rooms.
- It is highly recommended that swimmers wear a robe or long jacket, and a hat when leaving.
- No spectators during practice time. The only exception is first (6) practices. 10 and unders may have parent help.
- Make sure to communicate ASAP any changes or absences for a meet.
 This allows line ups to be adjusted/made and meets start can start on time.
- Swimmer will sit at meets with their age groups. Swimmers are responsible for cleaning up their area...please make sure to communicate that with your children.
- Swimmers should **NOT** have electronics on pool deck at any time especially during meets.

• Swimmers need to stay until the end of meets unless communicated and approved by a coach.

- Swimmers will need Googles, Fins, Suits and Caps.

- The REMIND app will be used for communication. Please make sure to sign up.
- **IMPORTANT FOR MEETS**: Make sure to fill out the meet declaration form at the beginning of the week when it is sent to you. Coaches need to know either way. Illnesses happen, please let coaches know ASAP through REMIND if your swimmer gets sick before a meet.
- Home Dual Meets should have attendance by all. The Governor Mifflin Invitational is paid for our swimmers to participate; however, we will need you to volunteer for the invitational. It is all hands-on deck. Both parents will be needed to put in time during this meet.
- **USA Program**...add on program for swimmers with experience. Think of it as a travel team for swim. Meets are far away. Please talk to Jen Caron or Jen Mazur for more information. There is more information on the website.
- Splash and Dash may be suggested in case your swimmer is not ready for the swim team practices. Mr. Kuser and the coaches will make that decision.
- Championships: There will be qualifying times now for Championships.
